## SAFETY POLICY

### FIRE

In the event of a Fire, please call the Event Organiser located at the club House. There are fire extinguishers at various signed fire points and the Fire Service can be contacted via the Event Organiser's mobile phone.

### DRIVING OF VEHICLE ON SITE

There is a 5mph speed limit at all times.

### GENERAL

1. All entrants are to report to the control desk on arrival, to register for Health & Safety purposes.
2. Children must be supervised at all times.
3. The Organiser cannot be held responsible for personal belongings brought into the Rally.
4. Any loading or unloading of scooters must be in an approved area and conducted by a competent person in a safe manner.
5. Running scooters must not be left unattended.
6. Inflammable substances should be stored only in approved containers.
7. Electrical connections should be made in an approved manner and should not cross a public access way.
8. The Organisers have the right to refuse entry.
